Campus

During this time of distance learning, we want our campus to continue being a healthy and safe environment for our Palermo teachers and staff members. In order to do so, <u>admittance to campus is</u> <u>limited to through a direct invitation from your child's teacher or the office.</u> You will be required to check in at the office to confirm your appointment and have your temperature taken. If your temperature is above 99 degrees, you will not be able to come onto campus. <u>Masks are required</u> to be worn by all persons on campus while inside a building, or outside and unable to social distance from other members on site.

Weekly Work and Zoom Meet Schedule

Our goal is to best support our families and students in completing the set expectations for each of their assigned courses. One way of creating support is by communicating the upcoming week's goals. On Fridays by 5pm, a schedule will be posted in your child's classroom outlining the coming week's instruction/assignments and Zoom meet times. Please use this schedule to help your child plan to be successful in fully participating in the class activities and utilizing hours of instruction and interventions.

Distance Learning Curriculum and Online Tools

Palermo Union Elementary School District has adopted Acellus as our online learning curriculum. Your child's teacher will enroll them into Math, ELA/Reading, History, and Science courses. A username and password will be created for your child. Parents/guardians will have access to their child's account to support their student's learning and hold their child accountable for completing thorough assignments and assessments.

Students and parents/guardians, will access grades through Illuminate. A password will be created for your child. Please contact Donna in the office if you need information about Illuminate. Students will be able to interact with their classmates and teacher through Zoom. Your child's teacher will send out an invitation with a date, time, and link to participate in live instruction and discussion. At the beginning of the year, your child's teacher will walk you through the process of signing in to each of the online learning tools. A copy of usernames and passwords will be given to the parent/guardian and the student. Additional videos and tutorials will be available in your child's Google Classroom and the school's website.

Palermo's Online Behavior Expectations

Creating a safe and respectful environment that fosters learning and kindness is at the heart of Palermo whether we are conducting instruction in-person or online. **The following are expectations that all students at Palermo Middle School will be held accountable for during distance learning**.

Google Classroom

- 1. Students will refrain from writing comments in the classroom unless explicitly stated by the teacher.
- 2. If asked by the teacher to write a comment, students will use appropriate and respectful language.

Zoom

- 1. Students will follow the dress code as outlined in the Palermo Handbook as applicable to distance learning:
 - a. No "spaghetti straps" (straps must be at least 1" wide), no low cut tops, tube tops, halter tops, or backless tops.
 - b. The midriff, stomach area or cleavage may not be exposed. Shirts that do not cover your stomach when your hands are raised will not be allowed.
 - c. No sheer or "see through" blouses or shirts.
 - d. Tank tops may not have oversized arm holes and must fit closely under the arms.
 - e. No short shorts. Shorts must be fingertip length. This includes shorts that are worn over leggings.
 - f. Dresses and skirts must be long enough to reach the fingertips when a student is standing with their hand next to their sides. This includes dresses and skirts worn over leggings.
 - g. Undergarments may not be exposed anytime. This includes shorts worn under pants and bra straps (regular or halter).
 - h. Pants must be worn at the waist and may not "sag" or worn low enough to expose any underwear. This includes "low rise" pants.
 - i. Any piece of clothing or accessory may not have any picture, symbols, colors, or words that refer to, or show, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, violence, weapons, gangs, or exposed body parts.
- 2. Students will use appropriate and respectful language whether spoken or written.
- 3. Students will only "comment" when directed by the teacher. Off task comments equate to a child talking and/or being off task during in-person instruction.
- 4. Zoom meetings may be recorded and may be shared on Google Classroom. Students who don't have permission to be recorded will need to turn off their camera and mute until recording is completed.

Please help your child designate a quiet area of your home that they sit in while interacting with their teacher and peers in a Zoom. Preferably, a wall behind your child works the best, as it prohibits other family members from accidentally interrupting the class discussion.

Please support your child to have positive interaction with their peers and teacher by encouraging them to "Make Your Mark"!

If your child fails to follow these guidelines and other class expectations, disciplinary action will take place.

- 1. The teacher will politely ask your child to stop their behavior and explain why it is not appropriate.
- 2. Teacher will contact your child individually and explain how the behavior was not appropriate and help strategize with your child so the behavior does not continue in future meetings.
- 3. If the behavior continues, the teacher will contact the Administration (Principal or Assistant Principal) and they will contact parents for a behavior meeting.
